



Thanksgiving Traditions



Thanksgiving traditions in the U.S. combine harvest celebration, national ritual, and evolving meaning. The “*First Thanksgiving*” of 1621 in Plymouth was likely a three-day feast of deer, fish, corn, and vegetables, not explicitly called “**Thanksgiving**” at the time. Over time, the holiday incorporated rituals of gratitude, religious services, and communal gathering.

A core tradition today is the **Thanksgiving meal**: roasted turkey, stuffing, potatoes, squash, cranberry sauce, and pumpkin pie. Many foods on the table—turkey, corn, pumpkins, cranberries—have Indigenous and Mesoamerican origins. While turkey was not definitively served in 1621, it became the iconic centerpiece in later centuries.



Other traditions include watching **Thanksgiving Day football games** (a staple since the late 19th century) and the presidential “**turkey pardon**,” a symbolic gesture documented since the mid-20th century. Many families observe a “**thankful circle**” or share what they’re grateful for, echoing the holiday’s original purpose of giving thanks.



However, the holiday’s narrative is being reevaluated. The romantic “**Pilgrims and Indians sharing a peaceful feast**” myth erases conflicts, colonization, and Indigenous perspectives. Many Native Americans observe a **National Day of Mourning** as part of Thanksgiving, remembering land dispossession and historical trauma.



In modern culture, **Friendsgiving**—a gathering with friends, often potluck style—has become popular, especially when family travel is difficult. Ultimately, Thanksgiving traditions reflect both continuity (feasting, gratitude, gathering) and change (revised understanding, inclusivity).



EASY NO BAKE PUMPKIN PIE CUPS RECIPE



Yield: 4 servings
Prep Time: 10 minutes
Additional Time: 5 minutes
Total Time: 15 minutes

These no bake pumpkin pie cups are easy to make and taste just as amazing as pumpkin pie filling.

INGREDIENTS

- 8 oz. cream cheese
- 2 cups graham crackers, crushed (+ reserve about 1/2 cup)
- 4 cups pumpkin puree
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 2 tsp. pumpkin pie spice + a little extra for garnish
- Whipped cream



INSTRUCTIONS

1. In a large mixing bowl or stand mixer, add the cream cheese and mix until creamy.
2. Add pumpkin puree, powdered sugar, pumpkin pie spice, and most of the graham cracker crumbs and mix well until thoroughly combined and smooth.
3. Divide no bake pumpkin pie filling mixture into 4 separate glasses. We used 8 oz. glasses, but you can also use plastic cups or make little pumpkin pies in jars.
4. Top each pumpkin pie cup with whipped cream, a hint of pumpkin pie spice, and the reserved graham cracker crumbs as garnish.




