NEWS AND TIPS FROM YOUR FRIENDS IN NATURE

NATURE'S MOSQUITO REPELLANT ALL-STARS

Here are some plants that everyone loves and wants; whether they know it or not. This is the case particularly in the summertime aka mosquito season. To be clear, these are not favorites of Florida's most disliked pesky pest – the mosquito.

The essential oils of these plants are proven to be the most effective repellants against the biting hoards that descend upon us.

I had a great idea to plant them by the front and garage doors. Them being Lemongrass and Geraniums. Except, they don't work just sitting there looking pretty. You have to actually crush the leaves to release the oils that repel the mosquito. Thank goodness the garden gods have figured this out.

These essential (in South Florida) oils are extracted from the plants and used in repellants, repellant bracelets, diffusers, etc. There a multitude of products available for purchase. Adding toxic chemicals like DEET are not necessary.

The Lemongrass grows well and fast in the ground. Don't look now, but it's a BOGO because it's also a great cooking ingredient. A gorgeous flower, the Geranium prefers a pot/planter here in South Florida and don't do as well. Of course, oils from the Citronella plant is also one of the top repellants. Rosemary is very happy here and is also a favored herb for cooking. Lay it on the grill and relax, let the aroma surround and protect you.



WANT TO BE SMART, HAVE A HIGH NATURE IQ?
Use a multi-layered approach and a variety of natural methods. This works best against this pest. Along with these essential oil repellants, understand and use nature's ways and means to help yourself:

✓ **PROTECT YOUR SKIN** with loose, light-colored clothing sprayed with natural repellent (they are attracted to skin's microbes, sweat, lactic acid, body heat, and dark colors)

✓ **PROTECT YOUR HEAD AND FACE** with a net (attracted to CO₂ – your breaths)

✓ **STAY AWAY FROM SHADED AREAS;** mosquitoes use it as protection

✓ **USE FANS;** mosquitoes do poorly against wind

✓ **STAY INDOORS DURING DAWN, DUSK**

✓ **ONE WORD – SCREENS**

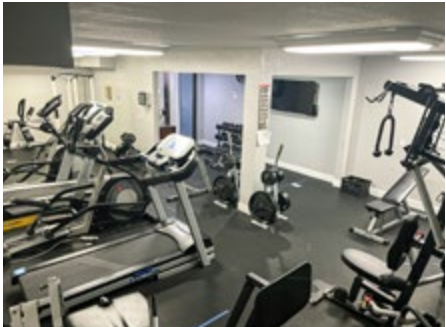
